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Annual Report for the Year April 2010 - March 2011

Aishabai & Haji Abdul Latif Charitable Trust is a registered charitable trust working in the service of humanity for last many years. The major focus of the trust has been promotion of the education of weaker sections of the society and also medical aid to the needy persons.

The Trust has been supporting several schools in Mumbai and Maharashtra. Our major contribution in this field is to provide supplementary services to the education department of Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) and Mumbai.

Main Aims and Objectives of the Trust:

1. To raise and promote social, cultural, educational, humanitarian standards and help in ameliorate the conditions of down trodden minorities and backward classes, also to help the destitute poor and needy.
2. To establish and run primary, secondary schools, colleges of Arts, Commerce, Science, Management, vocational training centers.
3. To establish and run the hostels and boarding for boys and girls to promote good education.
4. To establish health centers, hospitals and also support the cases who are in need of medical and surgical help.
5. To provide scholarship and educational assistance to poor, needy and deserving students.
6. To establish and run library, hostels, high school, non formal educational classes, adult literacy and coaching classes and also support such classes and school being run by others for the promotion of education.
7. To establish institutions specially to support the cause of women's education and empowerment.

School Support Program:

Aishabai & Haji Abdul Latif Charitable Trust has been working in the field of education for several years. One of our largest work initiatives is in Mumbai Municipal Schools. At present we have adopted 17 Schools with 43 Sections and support the education of 18894 children in many ways.

Our major responsibility under the adoption scheme is to provide services to children. Whenever Municipal Corporation is not able to provide adequate resources the Trust has been providing Teachers in all these schools as there is large shortfall of trained people and the Government does not have adequate teachers. Trust teachers and the coordinators have been providing extra coaching and the necessary guidance and counseling to the students attending these schools. Owing to this collaborative effect with BMC, we see visible changes in the area of decrease in dropout rates, increased motivation to pursue the higher studies, better result at matriculation exams and increase in confidence.

Activities held in the School under the described motto, following action have been done during June to May 11.

1. Teachers Training program and workshops conducted during the summer and Diwali vacation period.
2. After re-opening of the school, Door to door campaign for new admission in order to increase enrollments in school.
3. Preparation of new Time-Table for all the students.
4. Distribution of Uniforms, Books, Notebooks etc.
5. Conducting Extra Classes for Std X.
6. Preparation of Daily, weekly and Monthly Planning for Students.
7. Appointment of New School teachers.
8. Scholarship classes were conducted for Std. IV and VII
9. Regular meetings with Teachers over their progress, syllabus covered and activities conducted
10. Competitions like Drawing, Craft Handwriting, Mehendi, Story Telling and Elocution were held.
11. Parents meeting conducted and results discussed with them
12. On the occasion of Independent Day, History of freedom of our country has been delivered to Students.

13. Celebrated Teachers Day and organized Eid Milan Programme in schools.
14. Filled the scholarship forms for deserving students and sent to the dept.
15. Conducted Smart Study Program for SSC Students and distributed - 'Most likely 21 Question sets' for their Board Exams.
16. Prepared school magazine.
17. Sports day and Annual Programs organized and celebrated in schools
18. Special meetings organised with parents of STD X
19. SSC Felicitation program organized.



Fazlani Institute of Vocational Education (FIVE)

Aishabai and Haji Abdul Latif Charitable Trust runs its vocational classes with the collaboration of C.D.O in Imamwada School, Meghraj Sethi School and Malad Township Municipal School. In these classes we teach Mehendi, Hand embroidery, Fabric Painting, Zardozi work. These classes are run free of cost for school children, drop outs and parents.

Here we have appointed **8 Teachers** for above mentioned courses and the strength of about **103 Students**.

The courses for girls are affiliated with **S.N.D.T University, Marine Lines** under the department of **Adult and Continuing Education** getting benefit out from the same.
